

advent calendar-Garland with boxes

Instructions No. 4120

Difficulty: Beginner 🍴🍴🍴🍴

Working time: 2 Hours

Using small, house-shaped folding boxes, you can create an atmospheric Advent decoration that also serves as a “advent calendar.” At paper crafting, you can customize the little houses with stamps and add fine details with markers. This creates personalized “advent numbers” and little surprises that look especially festive on a fir garland. Ideal for beginners and perfect for lovingly decorating a windowsill, shelf, or entryway.



advent calendar-How to Make a Garland with a Folded-Box House

Fold the boxes and prepare them to be sturdy. Carefully fold each little house and box along the pre-creased edges. Press down on the folds with your finger or a blunt object. This ensures clean edges and keeps the boxes from

losing their shape when you fill them. Don't close the flaps completely until you know where the hanger will go later.

Stamping the houses: Create patterns without overloading them Stamp the little houses and boxes as you like. It's better to repeat small motifs like stars, twigs, or winter symbols in a calm, rhythmic pattern rather than placing a single large motif everywhere. This creates a harmonious look that doesn't appear cluttered, even when many boxes are grouped together. Let the stamp ink dry briefly so nothing smudges as you continue working. Add Details with a "marker" and Create Accents With a "marker," you can add fine lines, small dots, and other details. These details give the boxes more character. If you add text, keep it short and easy to read.

advent numbers : Clearly Visible and Evenly Spaced Next, stick the "advent numbers" onto the houses and boxes. Position the numbers on a flat surface whenever possible so they don't come loose at the edges. Fill and seal securely. Don't fill the boxes until the stamps and marker are completely dry. This keeps everything clean. Choose light, small items so the folding boxes hang securely on the garland. Close the boxes tightly so nothing slips out when you hang them and the little houses keep their shape.

Hanging: Tie to the fir garland with glitter cord Cut the glitter cord into appropriate lengths and tie the boxes securely to it. Make sure the knots are roughly the same length so that the advent calendar-elements hang at different heights but are evenly spaced. Then attach the cords to the fir garland. This creates a festive advent calendar-garland that serves as both a decoration and a countdown. Now it's your turn!
