# Baked Valentine's Day Greeting

The way to a man's heart is through his stomach. So what better **Valentine's Day** gift than a homemade heart?



#### Here's how it works

Make a cookie dough and cut out half the hearts

Bake the biscuits on a baking tray lined with baking paper for 10 - 15 minutes at 150°C in a preheated oven Make a negative-Stencil for the Cupid from the template, cutting out the areas within the contours. After cooling, transfer the Cupid with sugar sticks to one half of the biscuit, label the other half Cut a cardboard heart to size and spread it with patch glue, stick on-Paper the décopatch and spread it well. Cut back the excess after Paper drying.

Now stick a pretty lace border around it with tape-Ribbon and you have a very special Valentine's Day present, which also tastes good.


Recipe for the dough: 1 egg 1 pinch of salt 100 gr. sugar 1 sachet vanilla sugar 200 gr. flour 50 gr. cornstarch 5 TABLESPOONS Cacao 125 grams. Butter for decoration: sugar sticks

Mix sugar, salt and eggs in a bowl Add flour Cacao and cornstarch, add butter in small pieces little by little. Knead the dough into a big ball and let it rest in the refrigerator for ½ hour. Roll out the dough on a work surface dusted with flour, cut out the biscuits and place them on a baking tray lined with baking paper. Bake in a preheated oven at 150°C for 10 - 15 minutes
