

# Creative Easter wreath made from casting compound

Once the drying time has elapsed, you can carefully remove your bunnies from the molds. Be particularly careful not to damage the fine details. If the edges of the bunny are still a little uneven, you can carefully smooth them with sandpaper. This will give your bunny the finishing touch and ensure a professional look.

### **Step 4: Further drying**

You're almost done! Leave the cast bunnies to dry completely for another 12 hours. This extra time to dry ensures that the bunnies are firm enough to give pleasure for a long time and serve as a stable decoration.

### **Step 5: Decorate the vase**
