

Easter box with eggs and napkin technique

It does not always have to be the classic Easter nest that and in the time before Easter our home beautifies. Make a table decoration out of a planter box, which presents classic Easter eggs and motifs in an extraordinary arrangement

And it's that easy:

How do I make an Easter box with Napkin technique?

First you prime your Easter box. Paint plastic eggs to your own taste.

While the planter box and the Easter eggs are drying, the rabbit napkin is now glued to white photo cardboard and the rabbit motifs are then cut out

Now fill the Easter box with Flower arrangement foam and cover it with Easter grass

A wire is inserted into each plastic egg, fixed with hot glue and shortened to a length of about 2 - 3 cm. Decorative ribbons is laid into a loop and fixed with a wire. The eggs and bows can now be easily put into the Easter nest.

Finally only has to be glued with hot glue to the front of the Easter box. For the perfect look we have additionally glued jute cords to the metallic corner panels of the Easter box in our handicraft idea

What should I consider when priming boxes and planters?

Before priming planting boxes or other painting surfaces, the areas of Undecorated products that are to remain unpainted should be taped off. Priming is particularly successful with painting sponges, the paint is applied more evenly and without brush strokes, without "paint noses".
