Easter moss wreath

Instructions No. 3005

Difficulty: Beginner

Working time: 2 Hours

Doesn't this moss wreath look fabulous? You too can make a great moss wreath like this in just a few simple steps. Find out how to do it here!



Use the **jute ribbon** to tie a bow and a loop for the **large** wreaths. You can fix the bow with **hot glue** and/or **pins**. Then cut off the **ranunculus** just below the flowers and leaves.

Now plug them into the wreaths, glue the **polystyrene eggs** in place and then stick or glue the **feathers** in place too. Now all you have to do is glue the **carrots** in place and then place a **wind light** in the centre of the **small** wreaths.
