Crafting instructions: Handle basket made from craft blocks

Step 1: Prepare the base Glue three craft blocks together twice on each of the long, narrow sides to form the base of your basket. Allow the glued joints to dry completely to ensure stability.

Step 2: Add the base Glue one block upright to one end of the base. This will be the future base of your basket.

Step 3: Attach the side walls Glue one block upright on each side of the base to form the side walls.

Step 4: Attach the carrying handle To create a practical carrying handle, glue another connecting block to the free end of the two upright blocks.

Step 5: Attach the top edge Take the second 3 blocks and glue them to the top of the upright blocks. This forms the top edge of the basket and provides additional stability.

Step 6: Sorting the colors You can now put your VBS Craft paint set into the finished basket and use it as a practical storage place.

Step 7: Personalize and decorate Personalize your basket by painting it with the colors from your set. Not only will you have an individual design, but you will also be able to see the colors at a glance.
