Instructions: Wish list board with Harry the moose

Difficulty: Beginner



With this great wish-board you can be sure that your gifts will work! The funny moose are stuck Napkin technique on the wooden board and the personal wishes are simply hung on small wooden clips.

And so it goes

At the beginning the inner part of the **shield** is primed white. The edge is painted red Handicraft paint

While the paint dries, cut the motifs **out of i Napkin t** and remove the two layers of white paper. Napkin varnish Glue the standing elk and various small motifs onto white, fix the others Coloured paper directly onto the white-primed plate. With the large motifs, this is particularly easy if the background is first coated with a glue stick and then the printed paper layer is carefully placed on top. As soon as the napkin motif is positioned completely straight and without wrinkles, it can be painted and Napkin varnish fixed in place. If the napkin motif does not lie correctly, carefully peel it off again and reposition it

The motifs that have been glued on Craft cardboard sheet are cut out as soon as the glue has Napkin varnish dried and then glued to the sign with 3D adhesive pads. Finally, the "clothesline cords" are fixed to the back of the sign
