

Maritime lanterns

Instructions No. 2702

Difficulty: Beginner 🍃🍃🍃🍃

Working time: 1 hour

Let the dark days light up with these maritime lanterns and have a beautiful and individual decoration.



As a first step, punch out an anchor from dark blue and light blue cardboard. Glue these to the lanterns with a little craft glue. Then tie a piece of strip ribbon to the temples of the jars. You can cut the tips at an angle. Next, tie the tags to the jars with the warp yarn. Now stamp only the punched out circles and glue them to the ribbons.

Finally, you only need to fill the lanterns with the appropriate decorative sand and push in the candle holders so that the tea lights still need to be placed.
