Paper 3D Easter Egg

Difficulty: Beginner

Working time: 1 hour 30 Minutes

Egg, egg, egg, what do we see there? A great **decorative egg** that is an eye-catcher solo as well as complemented with decorative figures and integrated in an Easter landscape. With our template and papers selected by you, the fan egg is easily designed.



This is how you make the great egg:

Transfer the **templates** to the desired **papers** and then cut out the eggs. In our example, four eggs were always placed on top of each other and sewn together in the middle with the sewing machine. Another option is to staple the eggs together. Now fan out the eggs.

For the decoration, punch out a banner, trace the edges with a **fineliner** and stamp a saying on the banner. Punch a hole on the side of the banner and hang the **bell** there. You can now carefully glue the finished tag on with craft glue. You can also glue the banner with thin strips of hot glue.
