## Soap with lavender blossoms

**Instructions No. 395** 

Difficulty: Beginner

Working time: 20 Minutes



Whether as a gift or to keep - even cast soap with lavender scent brings back the summer. Due to the elegant relief inlays the soap bars get a filigree surface directly while pouring - very decorative!

## It'sthat simple

Cut approx. 100 g of casting soap per soap into pieces and melt in a ladle in a water bath. Add a few drops of scented oil to the liquid soap mass and stir. Just before you pour the melted soap into the mould, stir the layender flowers into the mass.

Put the relief inlay into the mould and press it down with a wooden stick while pouring the molten soap, otherwise it will float upwards. After about 30 minutes the hardened soap can be removed from the mould.

## Tip

Then pack the cast soap in stamped <u>Straw silk paper</u> - this one looks especially natural as gift wrapping paper, looks great and shows that it is homemade soap. Such a gift is always well received!
