

The Light Snowman

Instructions No. 407

Difficulty: Advanced 

Welcome to winter! **Make a light snowman** to give your winter decoration the right shine. With it you create a real feast for the eyes, for example for your entrance area.



It's that simple

Snowman:

Paint the scarf and cap with a mixture of Azure and white. After drying, shade with pure Azure and set accents. The nose Orange paint. Spread on the rest of the surface Structure Paste and allow to dry thoroughly.

Accentuate the contours with fine black brush strokes. Insert the fairy lights and fix them with hot glue from the back.

Fence:

Prime fence with Brown and let dry. Use a brush to dab decorative snow on the Acrylic- snowflakes and allow to dry thoroughly. Spread some of the Spatula decorative snow on the fence with a brush. Let it also dry well. Fix the snowflakes to the fence with hot glue.

"Welcome" sign:

Primer the sign with a mixture of white and Azure and after drying emphasize the edges with pure Azure . Apply a little decorative snow to individual parts of the lettering with Spatula and allow to dry thoroughly. Apply a little decorative snow to Acrylic Stars with a nudge brush and, when dry, apply hot-melt adhesive from the back as desired
