Base	approx	23 x 23
Height	approx	12
After felting

All measurements in cm

MATERIALS

Schachenmayr Wash + Filz-it!, 50 g ball

Color 00035 (linen), 3 balls

Check the label on the ball band and be sure to use balls with the same dye lot number. The amount of yarn needed can vary from person to person.

1 set (5) size US 13 (9 mm) double-pointed needles (dpn)
Tapestry needle

GAUGE

Before felting: 11 sts and 16 rnds = 4 x 4"/10 cm x 10 cm over St st;

Before felting: 11 sts and 18 rnds = 4 x 4"/10 cm x 10 cm over ridge pattern.

STITCH GLOSSARY

Stockinette Stitch (St st):

Knit every round.

Ridge Pattern:

★ Purl 2 rnds, knit 2 rnds; rep from ★ (4 rnds) for ridge pat.

Increases for the Base:

Follow the chart. The sts are shown as they appear of the right side. Work rnds 1–18 once.

INSTRUCTIONS

NOTE: The Basket begins in the center of the Base and is knit in rounds.

Cast on 8 sts, divide evenly over 4 needles (2 sts per needle). Join to work in rounds. Work in St st (k every rnd) and follow the chart for the increases (work the repeat 4 times around).

After the 2nd round, 4 sts are increased, then on the following even-numbered rounds, 8 sts are increased.

After 18 rnds (= approx 4½") have been worked, there are 76 sts on the needles (19 sts per needle).

For the body of the basket, continue in ridge pat, and on the first rnd, purl each yo through the back loop.

After 22 rnds (= approx 4") bind off all sts.

FINISHING

Weave in ends, and in the center of the base, draw the cast-on tail through the cast-on sts and pull tog to close the hole.

Felting

Follow the "General Information" on felting in the washing machine at 40°.

Pull the basket into shape and let dry.

Stitch Key

- = k1
- = yo
- = k1 through back loop into the yo of previous rnd

ABBREVIATIONS

- k = knit
- rep = repeat
- rnd (s) = round(s)
- st(s) = stitch(es)
- yo = yarn over
