KNOTS USED: Square knot Gathering knot

PREPARING OUR WORKSPACE

To carry out this work, it is advisable to do it by hanging the hoop from a macrame frame, rack or coat rack, or any part of your house with light where you can hang it.

When working with such long ropes, it is preferable to hang them high, and work standing or sitting.

BEFORE STARTING

Cut 24 ropes (3,5 meters each) and 4 ropes (1,5 cm each).

STEP BY STEP:

STEP 1:

Fold all 24 (3,5 m) of the macrame cords and place them on a stick that can move (where it could be remove). Organize the strings in group of 4 ropes.



STEP 2:

With each group of 4 ropes we make a **square knot**. In total, we make 6 **square knots**.



STEP 3:

Raise the knots, they are on the top of the stick.



STEP 4:

For the next row, we keep two ropes on the right and two ropes on the left apart and again make groups of 4 ropes to make **square knots**. This row has 5 square knots 5cm from the previous knots. Turn the stick and repeat this step.



STEP 5:

With the four ropes on each side make a **square knot**.



STEP 6:

Continue making a square knotted net until 8 complete turns of knots and a length of approximately 40cm.



STEP 7:

On the next round, we focus on one half of the bag. We make all the **square knots** continuing with the net except the central knot.



STEP 8:

Divide the 24 strings of this half into two groups of 12 to form the handle.



STEP 9:

With the 1,5m long rope. Make a **gathering knot** on the left side holding the 24 ropes.



STEP 10:

Repeat step 9 on the right side and cut the excess rope.







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STEP 11: Repeat steps 6-10 with the other 24 strings.



STEP 12: Take the bag off the stick.



Note: Due to the fact, that Crafty Fine yarn is recycled from colour-assorted textile material and not re-dyed there can be slight variations in color and thickness. We therefore recommend buying enough yarn for your project. We also advise to use a crochet needle without handle, which is easier to work with. The first stitches might be a little bit hard to work, but you will soon get used, and the final result is worth it.

WASHING ADVICE

Always wash in as warm a water temperature as possible - up to the temperature recommended, with a short spin. Use a lot of water if hand washing. For darker colours we recommend the use of discolouration sheets. Do not bleach.

Do not tumble dry. Drip-dry on a horizontal surface. Iron on a hot temperature setting using a damp cloth. Professional dry cleaning in tetrachloroethylene.

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
