Crochet Basket in Knitted Stitch

TENSION

9 dc x 10 rows = 10 x 10 cm

ABBREVIATIONS

sl st	slip stitch
dc	double crochet
ch	chain
st(s)	stitch(es)
rd	round
kst	knitted stitch

NOTES

The knitted stitch is a variation of the double crochet: you do not work through the two loops on top of the stitch but through the V-formed "heart" of the stitch (see picture 1), thus a quite dense structure is built, which looks like a knitted stitch. For the sides of the basket the knitted stitches are worked alternately with double crochet stitches, which are worked into the back loop of the previous round. A look like a brioche pattern is created that way. It is important to work loosely so that the hook can easily be inserted into the "heart" of the stitches, which is rather dense.



INSTRUCTION

Base: Start with a Magic Ring in which 8 dc are worked = 1st rd, closed with a sl st.

Rd 2: 1 ch (does not count as stitch), 1 inc in every stitch (16 sts)

Rd 3: 1 ch (does not count as stitch), * 1 dc, 1 inc*, rep von * to * to end of round (24 sts)

Rd 4: 1 ch (does not count as stitch), * 2 dc, 1 inc*, rep from * to * to end (32 sts)

Rd 5: 1 ch (does not count as stitch), * 3 dc, 1 inc*, rep from * to * to end (40 sts)

Rd 6: 1 ch (does not count as stitch), * 4 dc, 1 inc*, rep from * to * to end (48 sts)

Rd 7: 1 ch (does not count as stitch), * 5 dc, 1 inc*, rep from * to * to end (56 sts)

Rd 8: 1 ch (does not count as stitch), 1 dc in every st

Rd 9: 1 ch (does not count as stitch), 1 dc in every st through back loop only

Rd 10: 1 ch (does not count as stitch), * 1 dc into back loop, 1 kst*, rep from * to * to end, 1 sl st

Work more rounds until the yarn runs out, close the rd with a sl st. The yarn might be enough for 10 -11 Rd. Cut thread. To weave in the ends, divide the yarn into single strands to make weaving easier and nearly invisible.

Note: Due to the fact, that Crafty Fine yarn is recycled from colour-assorted textile material and not re-dyed there can be slight variations in color and thickness. We therefore recommend buying enough yarn for your project. We also advise to use a crochet needle without handle, which is easier to work with. The first stitches might be a little bit hard to work, but you will soon get used, and the final result is worth it.

WASHING ADVICE

- Always wash in as warm a water temperature as possible - up to the temperature recommended, with a short spin. Use a lot of water if hand washing. For darker colours we recommend the use of discolouration sheets.
- Do not bleach.
- Do not tumble dry. Drip-dry on a horizontal surface.
- Iron on a hot temperature setting using a damp cloth.
- Professional dry cleaning in tetrachloroethylene.
- Do not use optical brighteners (or any detergent containing optical brighteners). We recommend to use a softener to preserve the natural softness of the yarn.
